

CHECKLIST FOR PETITION TO REMOVE CONDITIONAL STATUS

- _____ Birthday, anniversary, etc. cards addressed to both of you from friends and relatives received between _____ & _____, including envelopes.
- _____ Joint/reciprocal insurance policies (health, rental/homeowner, joint life, auto)
- _____ Joint bank statements from _____ to _____.
- _____ Copy of _____ tax return(s).
- _____ Certified copy of child's birth certificate.
- _____ Current home address; dates at prior addresses.
- _____ _____'s current employer, address, telephone number, supervisors name, job title. Prior positions held, employer, addresses, dates
- _____ Dates, position, name of company and address of your prior employers
- _____ Copy of lease or mortgage contracts showing joint occupancy and/or ownership of your communal residence.
- _____ Financial records showing joint ownership of assets and/or joint responsibilities for liabilities.
- _____ Other documentation establishing the bonafides of your marital relationship. This can include such items as employment records designating the other as beneficiary for employee benefits, or whom to contact in case of an emergency, cards and/or correspondence, utility bills, and the like.

You will need to obtain at least two affidavits from friends, relatives, business colleagues and/or clergy who know that you have been living together. I am enclosing draft affidavits that can be supplemented depending on the facts in each circumstance. I prefer that you obtain affidavits from those people that you socialize with frequently.

Once the documentation is submitted, it is up to the Immigration and Naturalization Service to decide whether or not to require you to appear for an interview.
